EMPLOYEE / WORKER REGISTRATION FORM



The Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 states that all Market Operators within Glasgow are required to keep and maintain a register of stallholders and their workers operating on their markets. To comply with this legislation, stallholders (and their employees) must now register with the Authority.

You should complete this form if you work regular hours on regular market days and / or you supervise in the Registered Stallholder's absence.

To become a registered EMPLOYEE or WORKER with Glasgow City Council Markets, you must fully complete this form, and return it to a member of the market's staff. In addition to this form, you are required to submit:

Two current proofs of identity, confirming your identity and your current address, one of which should be photographic. E.g. Drivers Licence, Passport, Birth Certificate, Household Utility bill, Bank Statement, National Insurance card etc. These documents must be of original format.
